She also shared a letter from Presbyterian Disaster Assistance which is funded in part by the One Great Hour of Sharing offering. This letter included news about the happenings in South Sudan.

Our collection was taken. Old business discussed: we will continue to take collection of items for Sunset Gap in the basement of the church until October 15th. New business: Our mission project for the month was Medical Benevolence. Beth moved that we give \$150. Vicki seconded, all were in favor. Our Thank Offering and lunch will be held on Thursday November 12th immediately following our worship service. Ruth will organize the program and Ruth and Beth will set up and decorate. Our search committee had no report, so Judy made the motion that we retain all of our current officers if they would consent to do so. All officers present agreed to continue in their positions. Lisa will need to be contacted to ask if she will continue as well. We need a volunteer who is not going to be attending the retreat to set up for communion at the church on Oct 1st as Zelma will be in charge of communion at the retreat.

We closed our meeting with the Mizpah Benediction.

Our next meeting will be at the home of Ruth Burkey. The mission interpretation will be given by Joyce Whittenburg and lesson 8 of the Bible study will be led by Beth Morrell.
